explanatory (factor relating) - CORRECT ANSWER Concepts theories that relate concepts to one another and describe and specify associations between concepts, can only be developed once concepts are tested by correlational research

predictive (situation relating) - CORRECT ANSWER Concepts that describe the relationship between concepts, are generated and tested by experimental research involving manipulation of phenomenon and/or concepts and how they affect one another

prescriptive (situation producing) -CORRECT ANSWER C theories that prescribe the activities that are necessary to reach defined goals

empirics - CORRECT ANSWER C way of knowing that involves scientific knowledge

coming from observation, testing, and replication

personal knowledge - CORRECT ANSWER Control way of knowing that is knowledge gained from thought alone

esthetic knowledge - CORRECT ANSWER C way of knowing that is harmony, beauty, expression; incorporates art, creativity and values

knowledge - CORRECT ANSWER Correfers to awareness or perception of reality acquired through insight, learning or investigation. Within a discipline, it is what we collectively see as a reasonably accurate understanding of the world as envisioned by that discipline, it is tentative and refined over time

Theory - CORRECT ANSWER refers to a set of logical interrelated concepts, statements, propositions and definitions which have been derived from philosophical beliefs and scientific data and from which questions and hypothesis can be deduced, tested and verified; it attempts to account for or characterize some phenomenon

research - CORRECT ANSWER Course to investigate speculative theory, refine and test the reliability and validity of established theory and ultimately generate new theory
