What are the clinical manifestations of ICP in children? - {ASNWER}nausea, vomiting, headache, blurred vision, increased sleeping, inability to follow simple commands, & seizures

Home safety for infants: hot water thermostats should be set at or below= - {ASNWER}-49 C (120 F)

Home safety for infants: crib slats should be no farther apart than= -{ASNWER}-6 cm (2.375 in)
