Using the dominant hand to apply the second glove helps prevent contamination b/c the nurse's dominant hand is more likely to have better dexterity than their non dominant hand.

The nurse should leave the cuff folded and make sure it does not roll up their wrist. If the outer surface touches their hand or wrist, it's considered contaminated.
